


DAY 6: SAINTE CHAPELLE

APPARITION OF NOVEMBER 27, 1830

During evening prayers, Catherine Laboure, a member of the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul, saw the Virgin Mary standing on a globe, with rays of light streaming from rings on her fingers.

Surrounding Mary were the words: "*O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.*" As Catherine watched, the vision rotated, revealing an image of the letter "M" intertwined with a cross, with two hearts underneath – one pierced by a sword, representing Mary's sorrows, and the other encircled by a crown of thorns, symbolizing Jesus' Passion.



Mary instructed Catherine to have a medal struck in this likeness, promising special graces to those who wore it with faith and devotion.


